Actual concentration = 1/5 × Reading value

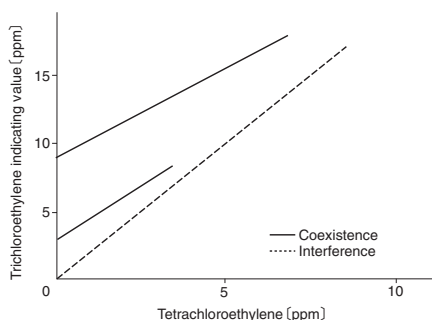


FIG.1 Influence of Tetrachloroethylene

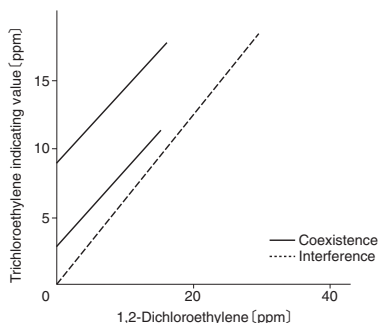


FIG.2 Influence of 1,2-Dichloroethylene
